



Whiteboard™

Description:

Trade Essentials® Whiteboard is a pre-finished wood panel suitable to form the carcass of cabinetry where a white, durable, easy to clean surface is required. Comprising of either particleboard or medium density fibreboard (MDF) with a melamine surface bonded to both sides. Whiteboard makes building cabinetry fast and easy, as the board is pre-decorated, all you do is cut, drill and edge it.

Applications/Uses:

- Non-porous, hardwearing surface makes it ideal for internal cabinetry
- Recommended for the construction of the carcass for general cabinetry
- Suitable as general shelving where visual appearance of the surface is not critical
- Where a high humidity environment may be encountered, the moisture resistant (particleboard MR or MR ZERO MDF) option is recommended

Limitations:

- Is not intended for use in an exterior situation
- It is not intended as a notice/marker board/writing surface
- Is not intended to form highly visible horizontal or vertical surfaces such as domestic or commercial work surfaces or door and drawer fronts for all cabinetry;
- For decorative panels such as cabinet doors and drawer fronts Laminex New Zealand recommends using Melteca Snowdrift or Melteca Warm White

Product Details:

Whiteboard is available with either a particleboard (Superfine or Superfine MR) or MDF (Lakepine MDF, Lakepine MR Zero) substrate. A wide range of sheet sizes and thickness options are available. With the surface finish offer comprising three options of Gloss, Satin, Pearl and Naturale. A range of solid edgings and melamine tapes are available to complement the Whiteboard thickness you choose.
